

ET Rover Pipeline – General Information

ET Rover has received Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) approval to begin construction of the pipeline.

The Township itself has no involvement in the permitting or regulation of the pipeline project.

According to Rover, construction activities are expected to begin in early March with tree-cutting along the pipeline route and then construction activities will be in full swing for the remainder of the spring and summer months.

The construction will be ongoing from March through October and the pipeline is expected to be ready to go into service in November 2017, according to ET Rover statements.
